CAR CARE TIPS

From the Greyhound Gazette

Early this summer, I had a bad experience when some antifreeze leaked onto the finish of my '23 Pierce Arrow. You know what that can do to lacquer. I had used Prestone because of the additive to inhibit corrosion that can occur between dissimilar metals in the cooling system. As a result, I decided to try a new product made for trucks to inhibit cooling system corrosion. The product is NALCOOL 3000 which is a cooling system corrosion inhibitor (and rust inhibitor) and coolant stabilizer. This product is available at most parts houses that handle heavy truck parts. A similar product is also available from Caterpillar under their own name. The 23 has been driven 1200 miles with a mixture of water and NALCOOL 3000 with the following results:

1. The engine runs cooler.

2. No water has been added to the cooling system in the 1200 miles since the NALCOOL 3000 was installed. With antifreeze, the coolant level went down about two quarts every day on tour. I think this was the result of foaming.

3. NALCOOL appears to have little or no adverse effect on lacquer or plated sur-

face.

NALCOOL 3000 is not an antifreeze, but it is designed to be used with antifreeze if needed.




