

Mighty Wurlitzer Concert/Silent Movie

"The Phantom of the Opera"

On Oct 28 a few of us V8 Club members made plans to attend a showing the the Silent Movie "The Phantom of the Opera" at the Nethercutt Museum. Myself and my wife along with Howard and his wife and Rob and his wife made plans to attend. However due to conflicting schedules Rob and Howard were not able to attend. So My wife and her friend Sue and her mother attended the show. The event had a full house and to my understanding had to schedule a 2nd show later that night to handle the requests to attend the event. It was very interesting as we found out that very few of the silent movies of that era were saved and this version of "The Phantom of the Opera" movie was made up of versions from 1925 original, 1929 revision and a couple of other later versions in order to have the complete movie. On another historic note the movie was was run on only operational original hand crank projector of the era. This projector allowed the projectionist to speedup/slowdown to match to the action and music on screen. All in all we had a great time reliving the History of the Silent Film era. As a added note the Nethercutt Muesum has planed other events around the Mighty Wurlitzer Concert Organ in November and December. 




