







## Age & Sludge by Howard Brown

Progress (?) continues on my '55 Ford Crown Vicky

As some of you may know, some time ago I resurrected a '55 Ford from its long (25 years) slumber on a local ranch. Since I brought it home, I have gotten it running (not great, but still running), gone thru the brakes, and taken it for a couple of very local test drives (first up to the end of my cul de sac and back, and then around a couple of local blocks). Each time I drove it, the transmission (Fordomatic) acted pretty much normal until I got home. The first time, it slipped badly when I put it in reverse. I checked, than added some fluid and it backed up hesitantly.

The second test drive, a little further, the fluid was full and it wouldn't back up at all (or go forward at that point). A couple of weeks ago, I decided that it would be wise to remove the transmission pan, clean it, replace the filter, and refill with fresh fluid.

I did this, (please look at the before and after pictures of the transmission pan; I scooped out two coffee cups full of sludge!) and discretion being the better part of valor (plus no one was around to help me push it off the street if it failed again), I tested it in my car storage area by driving it forward 25 feet and then back. I repeated this about 6 or 7 times and it worked!

I thought I was ready for my local test route, until I got out of the car and noticed something leaking. Guess what; it was NOT the transmission, now the fuel pump decided 25 years was enough for the diaphragm and it was squirting fuel out of the vent hole on the main body of the pump. I ordered a rebuilding kit from a company in Massachusetts by the name of 'Then and Now Carburetors'. I have dealt with them in the past for fuel pump and carburetor kits. As a matter of fact, I just recently rebuilt the carburetor on this same car using one of their kits. The fuel pump was interesting because they informed me that this car could have one of three different pumps by manufacturer and within manufacturer there are variations. We got it figured out and I ordered the kit. When I took the pump apart, I found oil in the pump chamber of the vacuum portion (small cracks in the diaphragm) and saw small cracks in the fuel diaphragm (which explains the fuel leakage). Please take a look at the accompanying pictures of the fuel pump, including the broken spring from the vacuum part of the pump.
