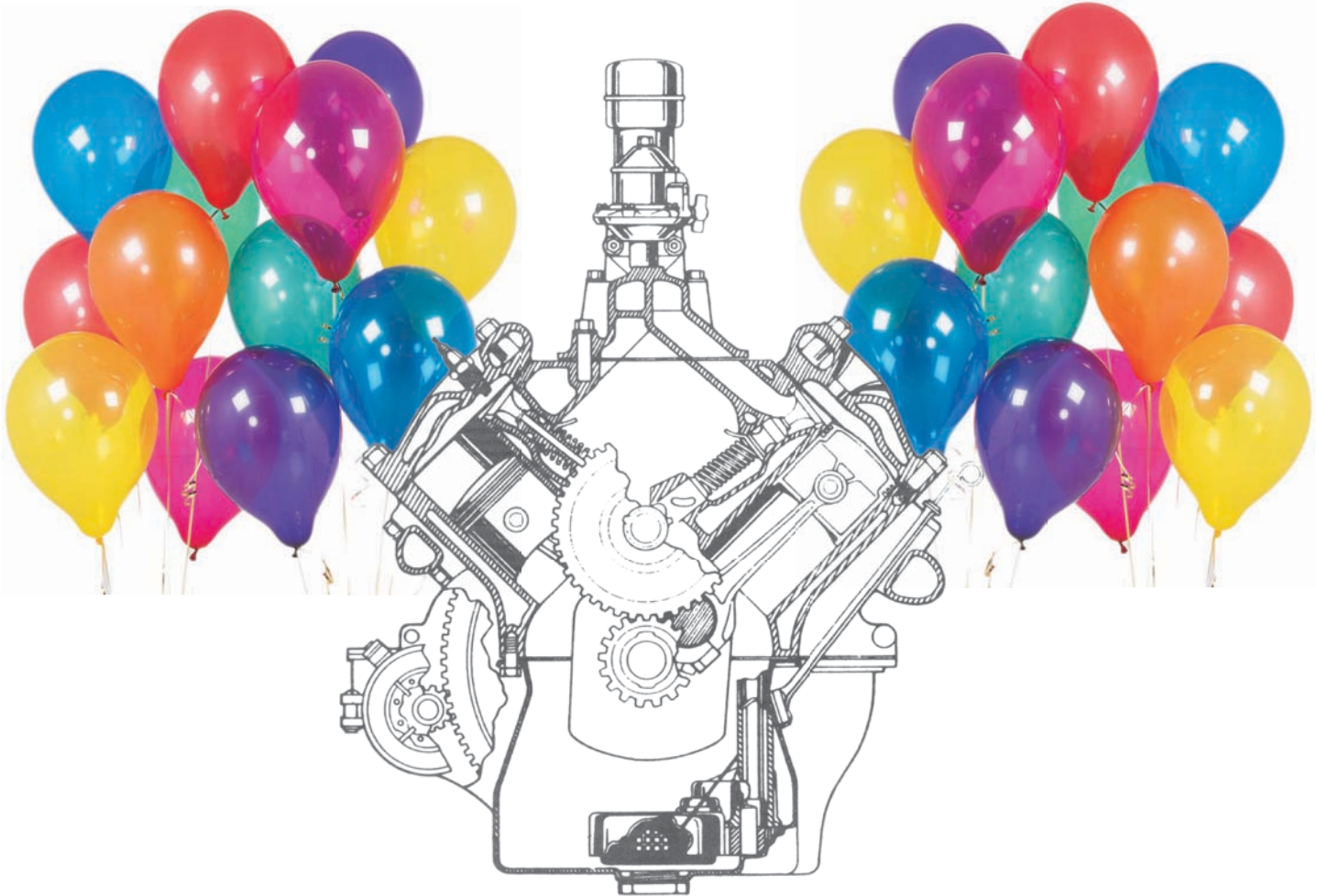

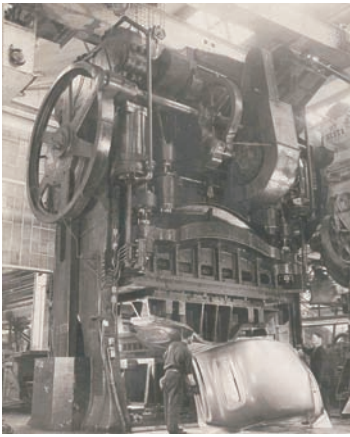

THE LIFE AND TIMES OF JOHN WOLF

We celebrate a life well-lived – our long-time friend and acting President of the Valley V-8's in 1997, **John Wolf** passed away on September 14th.

Born in 1931, he married his high school sweetheart, Virginia. John served honorably in the U.S. Army during the Korean war. He and Virginia had two children, Diana and Jeanette.

John's passion took him to building racing engines for cars and boats and even built one for a Streamliner that ran at Bonneville – winning awards.

He was always a car guy. He owned a great many cars in his lifetime – but mostly '40's and one '36 – all Fords.

He loved smoking his pipe and telling stories of the good old racing days...all the while imparting valuable technical information to his fellow club buddies and most anyone who would listen. He was our club's technical advisor for a very long time.

John saved the day one time for me when the coil in my '40 two-door sedan died, while on a tour, and he knew exactly what the problem was and, had a spare coil with him to fix my car. What a guy! Friends forever after that.

Seemingly shy and reserved, John was a larger than life Ford club advocate and proved his love for our Fords always. His legend will live on.
